I can imagine your reluctance to respond but it is very important indeed for everyone to know exactly where their MP stands on this very important principle. Sitting on the fence is neither credible nor an option.

Within the next week or so an Action Group will be announced made up of the very many people who responded to the recent PC circular. The reponse was tremendous from the like of Judges, Barristers, Solicitors, Senior Local Government Officers, Chartered Accountants, Senior Press and Media Executives, PR executives, Planning & Environment Experts, Civil Engineers and many others all united in shock and anger at the clearly implied scale of Imperial's aspirations.

Have absolutely no doubt whatsoever that those few who are presently keeping a relatively open mind believing that only the brownfield content is involved will be horrified if it emerges that Imperial want to plunder any greenfield AONB land.

One of the first tasks of the Action Group's Communications & PR section will be to identify those key people and organisations who do not support an unequivocal rejection of greenfield AONB development so that appropriate strategy can be decided.
